ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

- Abstract Submission Opens on 12 July 2025
- Abstract Submission Closes on 1 October 2025
- Abstract Acceptance Notification by 15th October 2025
 (Note: Acceptance of abstracts is subject to approval by the jury. The decision of the jury is final.)

Guidelines for abstract submission

- Each author can present only up to 2 abstracts.
- Abstracts submitted should preferably be original research work.
- Abstracts already published or presented at previous conferences should not be submitted.
- Abstracts may be submitted under the competitive or non-competitive sections.
- Abstracts may be submitted for oral/poster presentation.
- Abstracts will be accepted only via google form (Scan the QR Code Attached Below).
- Abstracts sent by email will not be accepted (Except Dr. Arvind Lonkar Award).
- Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered
- Abstracts already published or presented at previous state or national conferences should not be submitted

Certificates will not be handed over to any representative.



PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Award Papers:

Only IADVL Maharashtra members can participate in following sessions. Post-Graduate (PG) Residents of Armed Forces colleges in Maharashtra can also participate in these award sessions.

Dr. A. C Parikh Award is given to Post-Graduate residents for best paper presentation.

One paper (Case reports / Case series) will be nominated by each Head of Department from medical colleges

Dr. S. L. Wadhwa Award is awarded to Post-Graduate residents for best paper.

One research study to be nominated by each Head of Department from medical colleges in Maharashtra. These can include Clinical trials, Epidemiological and Investigational studies.

Dr. D. J. PATIL Award Session shall comprise papers on most interesting case from life members of IADVL Maharashtra. The best presentation will be given the award. (This award is not open to residents.)

(Minimum 3, Maximum 5 papers will be selected from amongst the entries for presentation)

Criteria for most interesting case:

- Complicated presentation of common disorder
- Rare presentation of a common disorder
- A case having diagnostic clue
- Reported but uncommon finding
- New and unusual treatment modality
- Unusual complication of therapy
- Unforeseen complication
- Unforgettable incidence in treating a case

Dr. Arvind Lonkar award is awarded to any member who has made a special contribution to the field of dermatology.

Post Graduate dissertations of students who have passed their MD/DNB at first attempt during last year are also accepted as entries. The thesis must be submitted in PDF format (file size under 20 MB) via the abstract submission link available on the official website.

Note: All other abstracts will be accepted only via Abstract Submission Link. Abstracts sent by email will not be accepted.

Free papers: Case reports and studies can be sent for free paper session.

E Posters: Case reports / Case series / Research studies can be sent for E-Posters.

One best E-Poster will be selected for (Dr M.S. Trasi - Dr. R.C. Shah Award)

There will be a separate award for E- Posters submitted under the category

'Pediatric Dermatology' and Leprosy (Dr. Ganapathy Award)





TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

Aurangabad is a historic city in the Maharashtra state of India. The city is a tourist hub, surrounded by many historical monuments, including the Ajanta Caves and Ellora Caves, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites, as well as Bibi Ka Maqbara and Panchakki. The administrative headquarters of the Aurangabad Division or Marathwada region, Aurangabad, is said to be a City of Gates and the strong presence of these can be felt as one drive through the city. In 2010, the Maharashtra Tourism Minister declared Aurangabad to be the tourism capital of Maharashtra. It is also one of the fastest-growing cities in the world.

Ajanta Caves:



The Ajanta Caves are 31 rock-cut cave monuments which date from the 2nd century BC. The caves include paintings and sculptures considered to be masterpieces of both Buddhist religious art (which depict the Jataka tales)[8] as well as frescos which are reminiscent of the Sigiriya paintings in Sri Lanka.[9]

Ellora Caves



Declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Ellora Caves are considered to be one of the world's largest rock-cut caves. Constructed between 600 and 1000 CE, the Ellora Caves consist of 100 Hindu, Jain, and Buddhist caves, out of which 34 are open to visitors.

Bibi-ka-Maqbara



Biwi ka Maqbara is a beautiful mausoleum located in Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, Maharashtra, India. It was commissioned in 1660 by Prince Azam Shah, the son of Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb, in memory of his mother, Dilras Banu Begum. It was inspired by The Taj Mahal in Agra (often called the "Mini Taj Mahal"). Its Architecture is in Mughal style, with white marble domes, intricate carvings, and gardens in Charbagh layout.

Ghrishneshwar Temple



Considered as the Earth's 12th Jyotirlinga, the Ghrishneshwar Temple is one of the top historical places in Aurangabad for Hindu devotees. Exhibiting prehistoric architecture, the temple flaunts a 5-tier shikara, beautiful sculptures, and intricate ancient carvings.

Daulatabad Fort



Constructed back in the 12th century, the robust Daulatabad Fort is considered to be a very powerful fortification of the medieval era. Perched atop a conical hill at an elevation of 200 meters from sea level, this fort posed to be a real challenge to defeat. This fort had multiple layers of strong defense walls and could only be accessed by a slender bridge.

Bhadra Maruti



Dedicated to the Hindu god Lord Hanuman, Bhadra Maruti is one of the three temples of the country where the god can be seen in sleeping position. According to popular beliefs the ruler of Khuldabad was called Bhadravati and the king was devoted to Lord Rama.

Pitalkhora Caves




Dating back to the 2nd century BC, Pitalkhora Caves happen to be an age-old rock cut cave that poses to be the perfect epitome of Buddhist architectural design. Carved out of basalt rock, this cave monument is set alongside a picturesque cascading waterfall, which adds to its incredible beauty and charm.
